WANTED: YOUR USED ALKALINE BATTERIES!



Zinc is an essential micronutrient that strengthens the immune system, helps fight infection and is crucial for healthy growth and brain development. Zinc is also a life-saving treatment for diarrhea, which kills more than 526,000 children each year. Approximately 200,000 childhood deaths could be prevented with increased access to zinc. The zinc in each AA battery can be reused to save six children from dying of dehydration. During the campaign, for each AA battery recycled, Teck donates the value of zinc recycled in support of the zinc and health programming in Kenya. An additional benefit of the initiative is when used batteries are recycled, they stay out of our landfills. Buckets have been placed at the back of each church for the collection of ALL your used alkaline batteries in all sizes from AAA to D and 9 volt.
